Dear Sirs,

Issuance of letters of credit (LCs) with realization clause

Paragraph 19(ii), chapter 7 of the Guidelines for Foreign Exchange Transactions (GFET)-2018, Vol.-1 permits Authorized Dealers to issue import LCs with realization clause for imports by companies operating in EPZ/EZ. This is to clarify that this instruction shall be applicable to HTP and other zones duly approved by the Government.

02. With a view to facilitating export trade during COVID-19 pandemic, it has been decided that input procurements under back to back LCs/usance LCs may be issued with realization clause on behalf of exporters operating outside specialized zones provided that:

- (a) ADs shall have to satisfy themselves regarding execution of the relative export orders;
- (b) there is a transparent arrangement under which suppliers are in agreement to accept the relevant LCs with realization clause;
- (c) LC liabilities will not be settled under 'net-off' arrangement with export proceeds.

03. As usual, ADs shall observe due diligence with KYC and AML/CFT standards. Other relevant instructions with regards to trade transactions shall remain unchanged.
