## Plan for Bangladesh Business Portal



#### Vision for the BBP designed to integrate a fragmented starting position



#### **Starting position**

- Five separate OSS platforms with different entry points and levels of digitalization
- Adoption of OSS low for non-IPA services; services of CLPIAs mostly availed through manual / in-person processes
- Each OSS platform with individual API connections with other gov't agencies, resulting in duplication
- Limited data sharing across gov agencies, resulting in investors providing the same information / document multiple times

#### Phased implementation of BBP in 3 waves across 4 years

#### Wave 1

Near-term (Year 1)

#### **Launch Core Platform**

- Services: Business Starter package, HR permit¹ simplification, and common services reallocation
- Features: High-demand features (e.g., integrated tracking)
- > Tech: Continue using existing tech capabilities (e.g., IPA OSS)

#### Wave 2

Mid-term (Years 1-3)

#### **Drive Broader Integration**

- Services: Digitize/ simplify sectoragnostic permits in key hubs
- Features: Advanced tools (e.g., CRM / IRMS integration)
- Tech: Integrate with National Single Window and BNDX<sup>2</sup>

#### Wave 3

Long-term (Year 4)

#### **Scale and Specialize**

- Services: Country-wide scale-up of sector-agnostic approvals / permits
- > Services: Digitize sectoral permits in key sectors (e.g., Core Apparels)
- Tech: Drive inter-agency coordination at scale through eOffice; Introduce AI / GenAI tools and advanced analytics

#### Wave 1 development underway, structured in two tranches:

Current Focus

- Release 1 to focus on fast-tracking the landing page with select features for early development (in progress)
- Release 2 will expand the Bangladesh Business Portal with additional services and features



#### Wave 1 features identified for development


	10 key features	proposed for Wave 1 (targeted by Feb 2026)
1	Know Your Approvals (KYA)	Info on number and sequence of approvals needed for a business
2	Service search functionality	Advanced search tool to enhance service discoverability
3	Business starter package	Simplified process for business registration through a single form and removal o redundant steps/ services
4	Unique ID/ BanglaBiz ID (BBID)	A unique ID for all businesses operating in Bangladesh; to initiate as platform ID
5	Common service relocation	Digital services from CLPIAs on OSS today to be offered directly through BBP instead of through each IPA OSS
6	Visa/ Work permit simplification	Digitization and simplification of the visa, work permit and security clearance procedure
7	Single Sign-on (SSO)	Unified log-in/reg to all OSS with one set of credentials
8	Integrated application tracking	Investor facing real-time monitoring dashboard
9	Relationship Manager connect form	One-click RM connect facilitation
10	Enhanced Mgmt. dashboard	Ad hoc reporting, data pipeline




#### Current Journey | Large portion of the Visa Extension process conducted offline

**Business starter package:** A bundle of key services essential for setting up a business entity in Bangladesh, offered through a single form and process



### Business starter package is designed to ensure the issuance of five key licenses within 72 hours



#### Key Proposed Interventions

#### Ease of Input

- Single form
- Templates for MoA, AoA, Partnership deed
- Single payment

#### Digitization

- Digitized encashment certificate
- Expanded coverage of digital trade license application

#### TAT Levers

- API-based validation of NID, TIN and passport
- · Autofill of dependent inputs
- Parallel processing

#### Enhancement

- Digital signature
- Operationalized 5-year trade license

**Investors:** Single access point for all CLPIA services and real-time application tracking



IPAs: Access to additional external services which are currently not available on their OSS platforms



CLPIAs: Optimized maintenance through single API connection with BBP (rather than 5 today)


